ALL Trailers and Animals must enter the grounds at the North Entrance of Myer's Park off of County Road 168. Lines will form in the trailer parking lot.

ALL animal coverings must be removed prior to entering the check in station

Goats:

10. Weight– there will be a minimum weight of 40 pounds and a maximum weight of 115 pounds.

Sheep:

11. OFFICIAL WEIGH IN will be immediately following fungus check. The minimum weight limits for lambs are as follows: Hair Sheep and Southdowns: 80 Pounds, and all other breeds including medium wool, fine wool, and crosses will have a minimum weight of 90 pounds.

All:

Inspection for live ringworm/fungus by the show veterinarian will take place from 7-10 AM on the Wednesday of the show week inside the cattle wash racks. Chapters and clubs should arrive based upon the time schedule created by the sheep superintendent or their designee. Each animal (market and breeding) will be examined by the show veterinarian(s) to gain access in the barn. All blankets and muzzles must be removed from animals and must be shorn according to the show regulations prior to inspection. The sheep/goat superintendent, show veterinarian(s), exhibitor, and chapter advisor or club representative are the only individuals permitted inside the cattle wash racks at the time of inspection. Animals with live ringworm and/or fungus (as deemed by (both) the show veterinarian(s) of the county show) will not be permitted to enter the lamb/goat barn and will not be permitted to participate in the Youth Show." The decision of the Show Veterinarian's is final.
